





There is a new student in class, and you aren't sure what pronouns they use. What should you do?

DO: Ask them, offer your own pronouns when you introduce yourself, call them by their name or gender-neutral pronouns, listen to cues from others, correct yourself if you make a mistake

Make assumptions about pronouns or identity

Scenario #3

You're on the soccer team with a friend who uses they/them pronouns, but recently you've noticed that they've been getting upset because the coach continually misgenders them, and they have started skipping practice to avoid it. What do you do?

Scenario #4

You're at lunch and you hear a group of people from your class saying derogatory things about the queer community, and using that word "gay" to describe a class project that they don't want to do. What do you do?

DO: If you can, respectfully let them know why they shouldn't use that word, or ask an adult to step in if needed _____Assume they have bad intentions

Avoid making assumptions – especially based on appearance



That Phrase!

Do you have any brothers or sisters?

Do you have any siblings?

Men have penises and women have vaginas.

Some people have penises, and some people have vaginas.


If a man is transgendered, it means he was born into the wrong body and used to be a woman.

OOPS!

What should you do if you mess up a person's pronouns?

<u>DO:</u> Apologize quickly and do your best to use the correct pronouns in the future. <u>DON'T</u>: Dwell on your mistake or say "This is so difficult for me"


