## Groups 2 and 4: Curriculum and Assessment

The group focused on compiling, creating, and evaluating the Spanish curriculum for a bilingual program. The same processes wereduto compile, create, and evaluate assessments for a bilingual program.

Challenges of the subcommittee:

- Lack of aligned curriculum in both English and Spanish
- Resources for Teacher Collaboration in a Bilingual Environment
- Authentic materials in Spanish and not just Spanish translations
- Funding for Curriculum and Assessment
- The difference between implementing the curriculum in one school versus the entire district (curriculum that is used and created for any school).

Key discussions the subcommettwanted to share:

- Teaching for bilingual literacy
- Planning time for dual language teaching
- Set clear expectations about scope and sequence.
- Implications for library and library materials.
